

Building and Grounds Committee

The role of the BUILDING AND GROUNDS COMMITTEE is to oversee all activities associated with the operation, maintenance, safety and security of all buildings, grounds, furnishings and equipment owned by the Church, except those items expressly the responsibility of another committee. One of the major duties of this committee is to evaluate any current St. Ignatius Loyola Church property deficiency addressing each with priority to the parish community safety. The committee also analyzes possible future needs and/or improvements and makes their recommendations to the Church. The maintenance staff committee members provide an ongoing check and input to the properties daily operations and needs. Many of the committee members utilize their construction experience to assess the buildings and grounds improvement projects. The committee meets on a monthly basis with additional meetings during ongoing improvement projects.
